Junior Company is an opportunity for dancers in the Performance Group who we feel are ready to expand their dance commitment. Following tradition, dancers from the Junior Company will eventually merge into the Senior Company as their technical ability progresses.

Junior Company will have a heavier performance and rehearsal schedule. Dancers will be required to take a minimum of six selected classes, to be chosen by the director, to ensure their technical growth. Dancers can then select their own elective dance classes in addition to their programmed classes. Junior Company dancers will receive the benefit of the training and hands on guidance of our qualified and diverse staff.

In addition, Junior Company dancers will also be given the opportunity to work in master class settings with dance and entertainment industry professionals who are in high demand. Junior Company will also be required to attend the PULSE Convention in Santa Clara, California held in February.

To be eligible for Junior Company, dancers must have a minimum of 4 years of dance experience, and must be a current Performance Group member. If chosen, we expect each member to make Junior Company their primary extra-curricular commitment. We will select our Junior Company members based on multiple criteria including technical ability and potential, previous in-class etiquette, dedication and motivation.
